Important Information

There is a maximum of 50 people allowed for service.

It is the policy of ECC to abide by the state's rules regarding face masks while gathering. We of course recognize those with a relevant medical condition or those who are leading worship or teaching will be unable to be masked. We thank you for your willingness to observe this as an act of love for the more vulnerable among us.

Currently we are retooling our children's ministry for relaunch, so there are no in person children's ministry at this time. Your children are welcome to join you in main service and to sit with your family. Please plan to bring a quiet activity for them.

We ask that you maintain a minimum of 6ft separation between all attenders who are not in your immediate family in all interactions and at all times.

We are trusting you to self-assess that you are not at high risk or not attend if you are feeling ill or have a temperature. Please take your temperature before attending the gathering. Any individual with a temperature of 100.4°F are requested to stay at home. Any individual with a household member who has been diagnosed with COVID-19 or with symptoms of COVID-19 may not attend the gathering.

HIGH-RISK POPULATIONS. Continue to stay at home and stay healthy. Use careful consideration prior to resuming public interactions.

STAY HOME IF YOU ARE EXPERIENCING COLD OR FLU SYMPTOMS. Not all flu symptoms are related to the coronavirus. However, if you are experiencing cold or flu symptoms, please consider those around you and stay home.

GOOD PERSONAL HYGIENE PRACTICE. Wash your hands often with warm soap and water, cover your sneeze and/or cough with a tissue, and throw tissues away after each use. It's generally recommended that you wash your hands for 20-30 seconds for maximum effectiveness.

Our facilities are regularly cleaned and sanitized, especially in the area of high-touch, high-traffic areas. Hand sanitizer stations will be placed at the main entrances and in the fellowship hall. Open trash containers are placed throughout the facility for you to dispose of your garbage. Food and coffee will not be served at this time. Communion elements will be offered in individual containers. Tithes & Offering: although electronic giving is preferred, a secure giving box will be located in the sanctuary as an option.
